Beginning with the 2014-15 academic year, Liberty Classical Academy will have a new pre-K through 12th-grade home campus in White Bear Lake. Signing an initial five-year lease—which includes an option for up to 10 years—with the St. Pius X Parish, Liberty will move into the St. Pius X school building—3878 Highland Avenue, White Bear Lake—on July 1, 2014.
