Shirts for girls and boys can be located at Lands’ End, they must be logoed. There is a fitted option (slim-cut) at Lands’ End for girls and boys if preferred. Older uniform items (only from Donald’s) will be “grandfathered in.” Dress shoes are to be black with black soles (not dress tennis shoes). We will be adhering strictly to our written dress code in the year to come. Liberty is a special place, and special places have special rules. We are so glad to have you in the Liberty community and look forward to seeing you again soon.
