Liberty Classical Academy extends the invitation to 11th and 12th grade students, with parent consent, to sign-out on their own during the lunch/recess period or finals preparation period to leave campus. The following conditions must be met and maintained prior to approval by the M/US Director:

- Parent/guardian of the student has signed and returned the permission slip to the M/US Director. Student and parent/guardian is fully aware of the Liberty Body of Values and that the student policies regarding behavior extends to actions while off-campus.
- Students must sign-out at the front office prior to leaving campus. Students must share with the front desk attendant their name and that they have permission to leave campus. The front desk attendant will cross-reference the request with a list of students who have parental permission to leave. Students must sign-in upon returning to campus. Failure to do so may result in the rescinding of privileges.
- Students are responsible for returning to class on time. Students will be marked tardy unexcused for returning to campus late. Few, if any exceptions will be made to the tardy unexcused return to campus if late.
- Students may ***not*** leave campus on the day their class is scheduled to clean up the cafeteria.
- Students are expected to adhere to the Student Policy expectations. A student may lose this privilege for the remainder of the semester for the following reasons:
 - Behavior Infraction(s)
 - Academic Infractions including failed class, extensive incompletes, etc.
